## Two state-wide candidates, numerous U.S. and State Representative candidates file for 2010 election cycle

FEBRUARY 18: The Constitution Party of Ohio ([www.cpofohio.org](http://www.cpofohio.org)) - announces today that it will field two state-wide candidates for office (U.S. Senate and Ohio Attorney General) and several candidates for U.S. and Ohio House of Representatives. The Constitution Party stands for limited government, is 100% Pro-Life and is an uncompromising advocate for 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment Rights. The Constitution Party achieved full party recognition and ballot access as a result of directive 2009-21 from the Ohio Secretary of State.

Robert Owens is Chairman of the Ohio Constitution Party and is the party's 2010 candidate for Attorney General. Mr. Owens was an independent candidate for Ohio Attorney General in 2008, achieving a vote total of nearly a quarter million votes, far exceeding any past vote total of an independent running for state wide executive office. Mr. Owens commented, "I am independent of political power brokers and will adhere to the Constitution and enforce the rule of law." Mr. Owens exposed the illicit money transactions of Democrat moneyman Montford Will in a series of televised debates in 2008. Mr. Will was caught funneling money to then State Treasurer Richard Cordray who awarded Mr. Will billions of dollars in public contracts. Mr. Owens is a former Sunbury prosecutor in Delaware County and maintains an active trial advocacy law practice in Delaware, Ohio.
